
## In an unlikely place unimaginable hope was born.

Jesus was born in a stable at Bethlehem, of Mary, a teenage girl, under the watchful care of Joseph.

In T.S Elliot's poem 'Journey of The Magi' the Magi ask themselves this question "Were we lead all that way for Birth or Death"?
