**It is true security.**

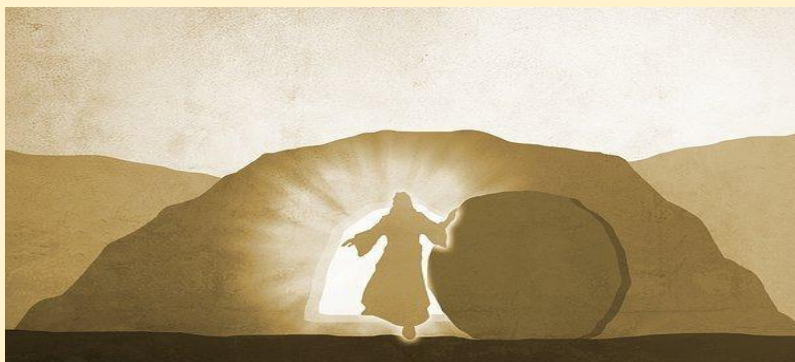
**True security is the direct consequence of divine union.**
